Newest eligibility: 70 and older

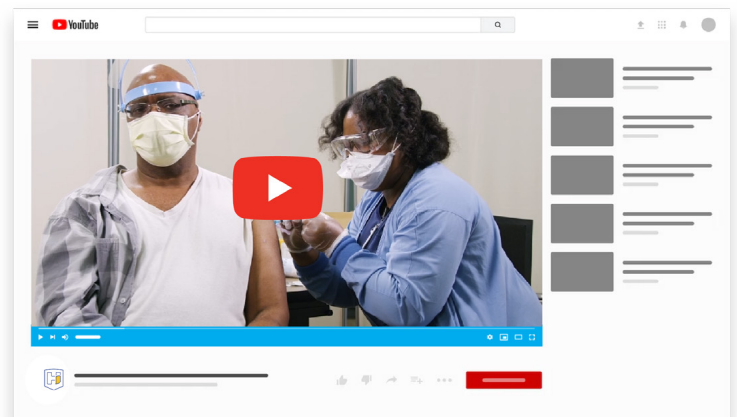
Age is the No. 1 risk factor in hospitalizations and death due to COVID, so we continue to expand vaccine eligibility. Hoosiers ages 70-79 should look for a postcard in their mailboxes letting them know that they can register at ourshot.in.gov or call 211 from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. EST seven days a week.

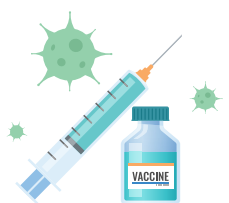


Vaccine by the numbers
