### New Recommendations: Dermal Fillers & Dose Spacing

The CDC recently released [new recommendations](#):

- People with dermal fillers may experience swelling at the site of the filler after the COVID vaccine. These fillers are used to increase volume in the face, in addition to non-cosmetic surgeries. Please consult your doctor if you have any concerns.
- The second doses of Pfizer and Moderna vaccines should be given by 42 days after the first dose. Make sure you schedule your second appointment when you receive your first dose. The second dose ensures full protection.
