## Free Transportation to Gary Vaccination clinic

Rideshare service Lyft, along with the Gary Public Transportation Corporation (GPTC), are providing free rides to the COVID-19 vaccination clinic at Roosevelt Park in Gary, for Hoosiers 16 years of age and older.

- **LYFT:** IU Health is coordinating the free Lyft rides. Simply call IU Health at 1-888-484-3258 and select option 9. An operator will arrange a Lyft ride for your appointment.
- **GPTC:** For a free fare to the vaccination clinic, simply tell your driver you are going to the Roosevelt Park clinic, then show the driver your vaccination card on the return trip.

**NO APPOINTMENT IS NEEDED** to receive the COVID-19 vaccine at this clinic. *(Language interpretation and support for those with disabilities, hearing or vision impairments are also available onsite.)*
