About the Moderna vaccine:

You just received your COVID-19 vaccine. The vaccine is **at least 90%** effective at preventing COVID-19. Want to learn more? Aim your smartphone's camera at this QR code to download the Fact Sheet.



After vaccination:

After you get the shot, you will be asked to stay for 15-30 minutes to monitor for reactions, which are rare. Many people will have no side effects. Some may experience:



- Pain or swelling at the injection site
- Headache
- · Chills
- Fever (usually less than 100.4° F)

The vaccine can't give you COVID-19.

Call your doctor if the arm in which you got the shot feels worse after 24 hours or if your side effects do not go away after a few days.
